The Peculiarities of the Complex (Comprehensive) Exam

The Committee examines the preliminary training of the candidates and the correlations between his or her acquired knowledge and the chosen field of research at the exam of admittance. Should there be a serious discrepancy, the candidate could not be admitted to the program. If the entrance exam proved to be successful, the tutor of PhD student prescribes in details the knowledge base in history and other social sciences at the beginning of the education process (in the first days of September of the first academic year) that the student must acquire in the first two years of his or her doctoral studies. The tutor provides a detailed list of source and secondary literature for this purpose. At the complex exam the candidate must render an account of the required knowledge that was assigned to him or her the aforementioned way.
